This transfer institution has agreed to accept the specified associate's degree from Florida State College at Jacksonville. The Florida State College at Jacksonville graduate will be accepted at the junior level, and is required to complete the equivalent of two years of full-time coursework to complete the specified bachelor's degree.

It is very important to make sure that your Program of Study at Florida State College at Jacksonville is Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Applied Science Degree. If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog.

Upon graduation from Florida State College, Bellevue University (BU) will accept up to 90 credits for oncampus Bellevue transfer students and up to 82 hours for online Bellevue transfers, from any Florida State College at Jacksonville AA, AS, or AAS degree towards the bachelor's degree listed below. Students will complete a minimum of 30 upper-division semester credit hours from Bellevue University to graduate with a Bachelor's degree in one of the designated Accelerated Bachelor's degree completion programs listed below. However, please review the Bellevue University website for the most up-to-date list of online majors available in the Accelerated Bachelor's degree completion program. Other majors are available online but may require additional coursework, beyond what a student in the Accelerated Bachelor's degree program.

The Bellevue University Accelerated Bachelor's Completion program is designed in a cohort basis of approximately 24 students. Students typically complete 36 credit hours in 36 weeks and the 9 credit hours of the Kirkpatrick Series.

There is no Bellevue University application fee at this time; however this is subject to change. Each student is assigned an admissions counselor who will assist the student with the application and initial enrollment process. Once the student is enrolled, a program advisor will be assigned to assist the student throughout his or her program.

General Education Notes:

- Please review the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER).
- CLAS (College Level Academic Skills): The CLAS is a <u>graduation requirement</u> for the <u>associate in arts</u> degree in the state college system of Florida. Students must meet one of the approved exemptions see the catalog for more information.
- The state university Foreign Language Requirement does not apply to students transferring to Bellevue University.
- All General Education courses require a grade of "C" or above.

Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of "C" or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both Florida State College at Jacksonville General Education Requirements and BU Major Prerequisites.
 - Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.
- Electives must have the appropriate AA (for AA degree students), AS (for AS degree students), or AAS (for AAS degree students) notation at the end of the course description in Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog.

Other Notes:

• Students must complete the Information Literacy Assessment requirement prior to graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville.

<u>Important Notes for students transferring to Bellevue University:</u>

- As mentioned on the previous page, BU will accept up to 82 semester hours for students graduating from an articulation partner institution (Florida State College at Jacksonville) and plan to transfer into one of BU's accelerated bachelor's degree online programs. Each additional course must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. The additional hours that the student would complete at Florida State College at Jacksonville, beyond the associates degree, should be completed in coursework that relates to the student's intended major at BU, or could be used to design a 'minor' with the approval of BU. There is no specific set of courses required as prerequisites for the BU major, as long as the student has completed and graduated from an associate's degree at Florida State College at Jacksonville. However, if a student wants to confirm that which additional courses will maximize his or her transfer of credit, the student can request an evaluation from BU.
- A minimum of 30 semester hours must be completed at BU for students transferring to the on-campus program at Bellevue. This includes the 9 credit hours of the required Kirkpatrick Signature Series.
- A minimum of 45 semester hours must be completed at BU for students transferring to the online accelerated bachelor's program at Bellevue. Students typically complete 36 credit hours in 36 weeks and the 9 credit hours of the required Kirkpatrick Signature Series, for a total of 45 semester hours.
- Required total credit hours to complete the degree at BU (a minimum of 127 semester hours for the Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science degrees and 132 semester hours for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Florida State College at Jacksonville Program of Study, as specified in the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog.
