**Other Notes:**

- Students must complete the Information Literacy Assessment requirement prior to graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville.
- Qualified students will have earned a grade point average of 2.0 and will have completed a minimum of 76 semester hours before transferring.
- No more than 88 semester hours of credit may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at NSU.
- Students who complete their Florida State College at Jacksonville course work under the terms of the catalog in effect during the term of their registration must graduate within five years or they will automatically be reassigned to the catalog in effect during their fifth year.
