- NSU will accept 87 hours for transfer into the BS Psychology degree. No more than 87 semester hours of credit may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at NSU.
- Courses in which students have earned a grade of "C" or higher will be accepted for transfer. A limited number of courses with grades of "D" may be transferred as determined by NSU. Additionally, if a student receives a grade of "D" in a required writing or mathematics course, or in a course that is a prerequisite or requirement in the major, the course must be repeated for graduation.
- Students who complete their Florida State College at Jacksonville course work under the terms of the catalog in effect during the term of their registration must graduate within five years or they will automatically be reassigned to the catalog in effect during their fifth year.
