Upon graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville, University of Maryland University College (UMUC) will accept up to 70 credits from any AA or AS degree towards the BS Computer Studies, as best fits the major, and a total of 90 semester hours from all sources combined (such as American Council on Education recommended credit and credit for prior learning). Students will complete a minimum of 30 semester credit hours from University of Maryland University College towards the bachelor's degree. The UMUC bachelors' degree programs require a minimum of 120 semester credit hours.
