General Education Notes:

- Please review the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER).
- Students will complete additional General Education courses at UNF.
- CLAS (College Level Academic Skills): Satisfaction of these skills is a graduation requirement for the bachelor's degree in the state college and state university systems of Florida. Students must meet one of the approved exemptions – see the catalog for more information. Students are encouraged to satisfy the CLAS while at the Florida State College at Jacksonville.

- Foreign Language Requirement: Students who have not completed two years of sequential foreign language study or American Sign Language in high school must complete 8 hours of college level foreign language or American Sign Language at Florida State College at Jacksonville. If this requirement is not completed at Florida State College at Jacksonville, it must be completed at UNF prior to graduation.
- All General Education courses require a grade of “C” or above.

Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both Florida State College at Jacksonville General Education Requirements and UNF Major Prerequisites.

- Professional Electives to be chosen from an approved list in Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog

Other Notes:

- Students must complete the Information Literacy Assessment requirement prior to graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville.
- Qualified students will have earned a grade point average of 2.0 and will have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours before transferring.
- No more than 82 (minus 30 hours in escrow) semester hours of credit may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at UNF.
- UNF will admit to junior-level status, toward a Bachelor of Science in Nursing students who complete the articulated AS degree in Nursing at Florida State College at Jacksonville, the prescribed coursework contained in this agreement, and all minimum criteria in order to be considered.
- Students who complete their Florida State College at Jacksonville course work under the terms of the catalog in effect during the term of their registration must graduate within five years or they will automatically be reassigned to the catalog in effect during their fifth year.
- Upon completion of the AS degree, students must maintain continuous enrollment and transfer directly to UNF within two semesters of the last term of enrollment at Florida State College at Jacksonville. Continuous enrollment is defined as enrollment not interrupted by non-attendance for more than three consecutive terms.
- UNF generally accepts courses completed within 10 years of Florida State College at Jacksonville graduate’s application to UNF. In other words, if a student applies to UNF in Fall 2007, and completed ENC 1101 in Fall 1997, they will accept the course. However, if the student completed the course prior to Fall 1997, additional documentation may be required to be submitted.
- Students who matriculate at a state university are required to provide proof of immunization against Rubeola (measles) and Rubella (German Measles). In order to participate in the clinical nursing courses, all students must have a tuberculin skin test or chest X-ray (negative for active disease if skin test is positive), positive titer for hepatitis B, and varicella. A health report must be completed prior to enrollment in clinical courses. Additionally, all students must also have professional liability insurance coverage, with a minimum \$1,000,000/3,000,000 coverage; CPR certification (for healthcare providers); and a background check.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.
