Online Food Handlers Training Certificate Program

The Food Safety First Principles for Food Handlers Program consist of an online training course and assessment. It provides food handlers with the knowledge and skills they need to safely handle foods for human consumption. Successful completion of the program assures food managers, regulators and trainers that the certificate holder has completed a basic course in food safety. The First Principles course is based on the on the principles and recommendations of the FDA Food Code and is recommended for people involved in the preparation, handling, serving and displaying of food.
