Florida State College at Jacksonville provides the opportunity for professionals in the food industry to earn certification through [National Registry of Food Safety Professionals](#). National Registry is recognized internationally by the food service industry for its tests and service delivery standards and practices.

Food Safety Managers

The Certified Food Safety Manager examination is accredited by the American National Standards Institute under standards established by the Conference for Food Protection. That accreditation makes National Registry's exam acceptable in all states and jurisdictions that recognize those standards set by CFP, and is an assurance of quality in the development and maintenance of the exams. At Florida State College at Jacksonville, individuals may take this exam by registering through [Pearson VUE](#) or they may take it in conjunction with the Food Safety Manager's Review Course taught through our [Continuing Education Department](#).
