Public Safety Telecommunicator Training Course (CWN 0250)

The blended (online and practical) nine- week course is designed for public safety telecommunicators that are currently employed by public safety organizations.

Participants will engage in online class work and be required to have supervisors sign off on their ability to demonstrate necessary skills.

Participants will acquire the skills necessary for receiving and dispatching functions related to 911 calls. Upon successful completion of this course, participants will be prepared* to take the state exam to be a Certified Public Safety Telecommunicator.

Tuition for this course is \$550 per person. A \$15 membership fee may apply if the student has not previously been a Florida State College of Jacksonville student.

* Course DOES NOT provide the required CPR Certification.
